



## Semester Report

Every school year Laura and I get to minister to thousands of students on the Auraria campus directly and indirectly preparing them to reach and influence the world for Christ. The spring is when we get to rejoice in some of the fruit of our labor sown in faith over the last ten months. As an overview, this past year there were approximately 50 students involved weekly in various Master Plan Denver activities. An average of 40 students attended AMP (campus worship service), 16 involved in consistent one on one discipleship, 6 bible studies first semester, and 5 second semester, and 5 students indicated decisions to receive Christ! This year was a new walk of faith as Laura had been pregnant and had Malachi, and we have been raising a growing family. Laura started an online women's ministry ([missionalwomen.com](http://missionalwomen.com)) and I have been coaching the nine new Master Plan staff as they work on ministry partner development.

Master Plan is on three campuses in Colorado: Fort Lewis College in Durango, Colorado Mesa University in Grand Junction and our Auraria campus in Denver. God is doing exciting things on each of the campuses. Statistics are not the full measure of what God is doing, but they do show to some extent the faithfulness and accountability of staff and leadership students. So for all three campuses during the spring semester there were:

- \* 680 evangelistic one-on-one conversations.
- \* 550 new students exposed to the Gospel in outreach events.
- \* 40 students indicated they made a decision to become a Christian.
- \* 852 one-on-one discipleship appointments.
- \* 23 small groups involving 110 students each week.

This June and July, Laura and I are helping to develop MPM as it grows by developing resources, coaching new staff and helping to plan the largest MPM staff conference we've ever had with twenty-six full time workers. We're also teaching and training our four kids under six, and taking care of some maintenance projects around the house.
