The 50 staff and students in the above photo (can you spot us?) helped to make Master Plan history! God put a desire on Master Plan staff members Nate and Erin Herbst's heart to expand the campus ministry to a new campus- UNM in Albuquerque New Mexico. And for the first time in MPM's history, the Denver, Grand Junction and Durango teams all had the same spring break which opened a door for effective ministry. On March 21st the confluence of students and staff, (and 14 children) flooded UNM for a week of spreading the Good News. We had a daily cotton candy "information table" at the center of campus where students lined up and got into Gospel conversations while they waited for their cotton candy to be made. The photo on the right captures 4 concurrent spiritual conversations. Each day we also held a sports outreach, another info table, did survey evangelism, held a Bible study and we held a large Wednesday night outreach. We estimate that together we spent 800 hours of sharing the Gospel message personally with hundreds of students. There were **21 people that indicated making a decision for Christ and we met 200 students who want to get involved** when Master Plan launches in the fall, (Lord willing!)
