Each speaker brought their hot topic back to the message of the Gospel. Many new students heard and are considering the Gospel as a result.

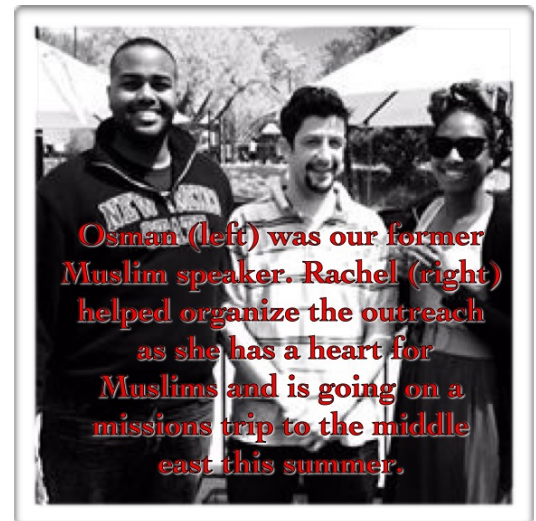
Summer Investment!
