On November 19<sup>th</sup>, Master Plan interns Rob and Angi, took students Hannah and Garrett 7 hours north to Riverton, WY to spread the hope and love of Jesus with the Arapaho and Shoshoni Native American peoples. According to JoshuaProject.net they are considered an unreached people group, right in Denver's backyard!

On the reservation, the team went door to door and listened to peoples' stories and shared the Gospel with many of them. They also got to visit people in jail and served an early Thanksgiving dinner to 30 people on the reservation. One of the highlights was getting to go into a family's home where the father had recently died. (pic. right) The team shared their personal testimonies and discussed the Gospel for over an hour and were able to bring the 4 young men to church with them.

What this little team did is a lot like Jesus's incarnation- giving up some privileges and going into the world of another so they can enjoy the greatest gift: Jesus! **This is what God did for us when He left His place, to come to our place, to take our place, so we could go to His place! We would still be lost in our sin if God did not show us that grace!** If Jesus had a "Let them come to us" attitude, there would be no Christmas. We imitate Jesus as we share the Gospel on campus, train students in ministry, and encourage them to influence their campus and world for Christ.

We love that this year has enabled us to win more students for Christ, build up more students in their faith, and send out more students to impact the world for Christ from secular colleges in Denver.
