## Going All In

*What does raising 3 million dollars, an evangelistic flash mob of 1,200 people "Tebowing", packaging 100,000 meals for Haiti and sharing the gospel on facebook have in common? They're all fruit of what God is doing in this generation of college students.*

Over Christmas break Austin and I sent two different teams of students to conferences. 17 students headed to "Passion" in Atlanta joining 45,000 other students to hear from John Piper, Beth Moore, Louie Giglio, Francis Chan, Chris Tomlin and many others. They were challenged to be a force for good for the glory of God through Jesus Christ. These students learned about sex trafficking and the 27million slaves in the world today. **Francis Chan helped them realize that this horrific evil can only be changed through making disciples.** These "poor" college students were challenged to give financially toward organizations working to end slavery. **They responded by waiting 2 hours in line to give what amounted to be over 3 million dollars!**

Austin and I took a handful of other students across the street to the regional Denver Christmas Conference partnering with Campus Crusade (CRU). These 1,200 students were challenged to go "All In" for the expansion of God's kingdom. They heard from great speakers and shared the gospel with many of their friends online and downtown. Master Plan students from Durango and Grand Junction also attended the conference. **During a campus time the majority of MPM students indicated a desire to do full time ministry as well as go on summer project mission trips this summer.**

God worked in student's hearts and minds at these conferences, but don't just take my word for it. Here is what students said about the conferences:
