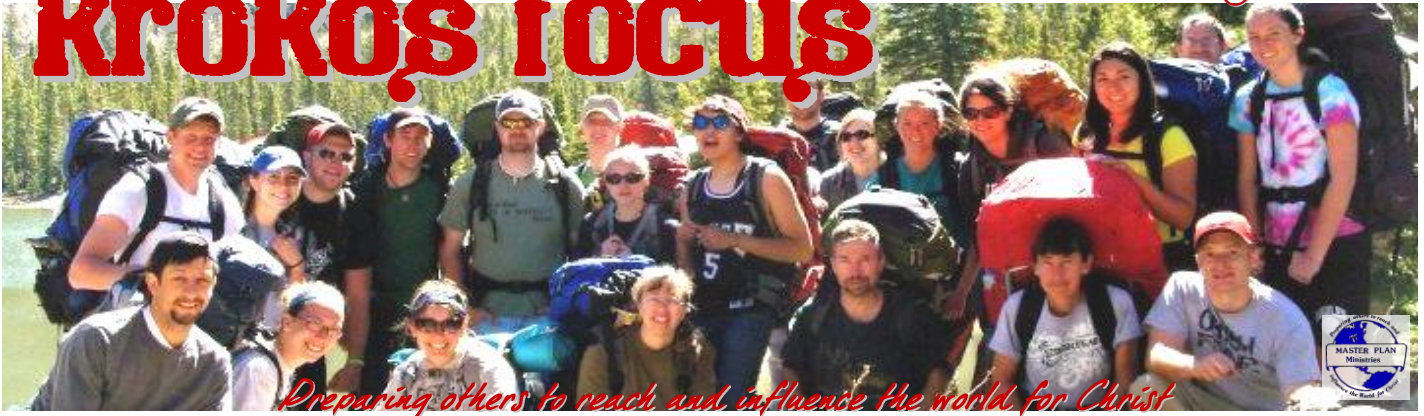


# krokos focus

Current statistics of students 18-29 say 65% rarely or never pray with others and 67% don't read the Bible. But God moved in extraordinary ways in student's lives in Denver this year. Look what He did:

We had over 700 students on our email list, an average of 45 at AMP, our weekly worship and teaching meeting, and an average of 35 students consistently involved in being part of the mission of reaching and influencing others for Christ. We surveyed our students and found:

18 prayed for several hours at half nights of prayer, 6 of who had never done that before.

22 were in a small group bible study, for 10 of them it was their first one.

8 lead a small group bible study, for 4 of them it was their first time.

28 saw God use them to help others to get closer to Jesus, 10 for the first time.

**10 got to lead someone into a relationship with Jesus this year, for 8 it was their first experience doing so.**

28 got to share the gospel with someone, 10 of whom had never shared the gospel with anyone before.

**30 cared enough to read the Bible on their own this year, 10 for the first time.**

30 really walked with Jesus this year, for 10 of them it was for the first time.

26 shared their story with someone of how they came to Christ, 10 for the first time.

20 spoke up in class as a Christian about truth or God, 8 of which had never done that before.

**Huge steps were made and it is evident God is transforming lives!** Thank you for partnering with us in seeing God reach and influence Denver students lives for Christ.

**crush fear** *“I feel more free now than I ever have before.” Katie*



May 19<sup>th</sup>-31<sup>st</sup>, 15 students from across the US, attended the Crush Fear summer project. They boldly walked through fears like sharing their faith on the street, rappelling off cliffs, eating crickets, confronting grocery store managers about crude magazines, a 24 hour solo in the woods, sharing their testimony at a local church and tons of other ministry, relational and physical fears.



Austin was with Paul as they shared the gospel with Rachel. She told them, *“I just told my mom that if I did not wake up tomorrow, I would be OK with that....I just wish I knew more about God, that someone would help me understand the Bible.”* Dayna got to share the gospel with a girl in a Durango park who gave her life to Christ a week later and is being plugged in with local believers. Alyssa got to lead her boyfriend back home to Christ over the phone while on the project and said, *“This has helped me get over sin issues and find guidance.”* David said, *“My fears I crushed had more to do with sharing my faith. I think I'll always share my faith with fear and trembling like Paul in the Bible, but I won't be hindered by fear.”* **The**

**majority of the students said they are now much more confident in reaching their campus for Christ, more empowered to serve God, and are not scared to share their faith.** God has done great things!
