Relativism, Sex Trafficking, Islam, Philosophy and Abortion

On 3-16, Luwam bought candy bars, wrote John 3:16 on them and gave them away as a tool to get into the spiritual conversations. She shared the gospel with 2 students who are now considering Christ. Paul is meeting with Ahmed, a student from Qatar to discuss the gospel. Garrett and Amber gathered 15 giant trash bags of winter clothes, did a training on how to share the gospel and hit the streets ministering to the homeless. These students are taking huge faith steps but not without opposition, they have an Enemy who wants to destroy them. In the last few weeks, Austin and I have been shocked by the lies and temptations Satan is putting in front of college students. At a recent retreat 2 separate girls were telling me they had been asked to be part of gross sexual immorality twice that month. And had one student consider and another attempt to take their life in the last month.

But God is at the center of this battle, fighting for these students and helping them look to Him for strength and putting them in a campus community where lies can be exposed (things like retreats, our weekly mtg, Bible studies, Friday night dinners etc). He has clearly led us to advance on enemy territory by organizing (or in some cases supporting students organizing) multiple events as a way to **bring the gospel to very dark places on campus and in the world. Relativism, sex trafficking of young girls, Islam, philosophy and abortion** are going to be confronted with God's truth and the gospel in the next weeks and months. We can not fight these battles without you! Please pray for us and for our students. Here are the specifics.

→**The Maze** is an illusionist who creates an environment where audiences are challenged to question relativism. He clearly presents the gospel giving students an opportunity to respond. This is likely to be the biggest outreach that has ever happened on our campus... ever. The show is April 14th

→**Philosophy & Christianity: Friends or Foes?** April 19th, a Professor at Denver Seminary has agreed to speak on this subject followed by a student sharing their story of how they came to know Christ. We have done 3 other similar events all of which had a great turn out where students heard the gospel and are now walking with Christ on campus as a result.

→**Justice For All.** April 11th & 12th, students involved with us are bringing JFA to campus to move the issue of abortion from debate to dialog and working toward making abortion unthinkable. This will also be used as a means of sharing the gospel.

→**Middle East.** Austin is taking a team of young men to the Middle East for two weeks in May to bring the gospel to this unreached nation where less than 1% of the people are Christ followers.

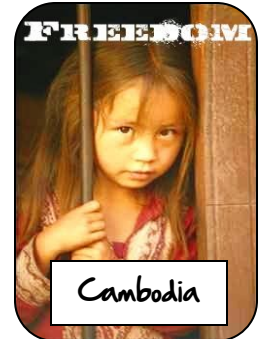
→**Cambodia.** I am taking a team of young ladies to Cambodia in July to bring the gospel and work with young girls rescued from and enslaved in forced prostitution.

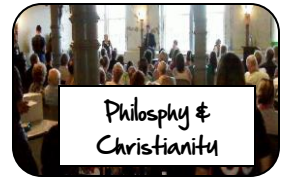
